Educational Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

One \$500 college scholarship will be awarded to a senior student from Jackson County who has applied and been accepted by a College or University, Community College or Technical School.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student who is the child of a Jackson County Farm Bureau member.

The scholarship will be awarded after successful completion of at least 12 quarter or semester hours of college up to the completion of 5 semesters. The student must have a grade point average of at least a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

If the scholarship is not awarded in the current year, then two scholarships may be awarded to eligible recipients the following year.

Basis of Selection

Applicants for the Jackson County Farm Bureau Educational Scholarship will be evaluated by a major in Agriculture or Agriculture experience (FFA/farming) and financial need.

Two letters of reference, signed high school transcripts, and short essay must be attached to this completed application. See details in application.
