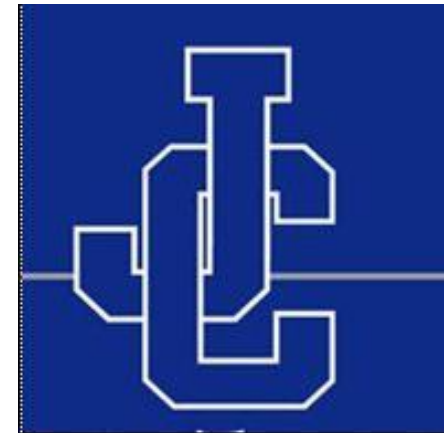

Jackson County District Goals for 2017-18\*:

- Overall Student growth, as measured by district benchmarks and/or summative testing when available, will increase
